Overview: A Season of Roots Taking Hold

The second quarter of 2026 marks an important transitional season for the ELGF Ghana program. Under the diligent coordination of Local Ministerial Representative Rev. Moses Kube, the programme has moved from initial livestock distribution into active veterinary care, field monitoring, and animal husbandry expansion planning.

Seven pastors across three distinct regions — Upper East, Bono East, Bono, and Greater Accra — are now tending animals, supported by regionally assigned veterinarians and strengthened by regular pastoral follow-up from Rev. Kube. A rabbit husbandry programme is also in development, with two pastors preparing infrastructure and a third potential recipient identified in Accra.

This report synthesises field updates, veterinary interventions, financial stewardship notes, and the spiritual posture that defines everything ELGF does in Ghana.

Regional Animal Health & Pastoral Updates

Upper East Region

Bolgatanga / Talensi District

- Pastor Timothy Mambo — 5 Goats, Tomgo-Yagzore
- Rev. Dennis Atiah — 5 Goats, Yorogo

Both pastors in the Upper East have confirmed their goat flocks are in good health. Rev. Kube made direct telephone follow-up to check on the animals and received positive reports from both recipients.

Rev. Kube is in contact with Dr. Ayine, the regional veterinarian assigned to this area. Dr. Ayine has assessed the animals as stable and will begin preventive medications and treatments at the

start of the rainy season — when new grass growth increases the risk of internal parasites and other seasonal health concerns.

Bono East Region


Tanoboase & Akrofrom

- Pastor Thomas Kodom — 5 Goats, Tanoboase
- Rev. William Inkoom Acquah — 5 Goats, Akrofrom

This region received the most intensive veterinary attention this quarter. On Thursday, 7th May 2026, Rev. Kube personally accompanied Dr. King Solomon (Techiman Veterinary Clinic) on a field visit to both farms.

Dr. King Solomon administered injections and deworming treatments to the animals and provided practical guidance on feeding practices and shelter management. He confirmed a standing arrangement to return every three months, with instructions to both pastors to call him directly if any unusual symptoms arise.

Rev. Kube's personal attendance at this visit exemplifies his hands-on approach as LMR — ensuring veterinary care is not just assigned on paper but witnessed and confirmed in the field.

Bono Region

Odumase / Sunyani

- Rev. Daniel Ekow Obodum — 5 Goats, Odumase

Rev. Daniel Ekow Obodum has confirmed his goats are doing well and that he is experiencing no problems with the flock.

Rev. Kube has made contact with the regional veterinary officer to establish a formal veterinary arrangement. The designated officer had briefly traveled outside the region but is expected to return shortly and be formally assigned to administer medications and provide ongoing guidance.

Greater Accra & Central Regions


Rabbit Husbandry Programme — In Development

- Rev. Samuel Ansah Gyan — Rabbits (Pending), Ashongman Estate, Accra
- Rev. Stanley Kelly Quaye — Rabbits (Pending), Kasoa, Central Region

The Ghana programme is expanding into rabbit husbandry, with two pastors selected as initial beneficiaries. Rev. Samuel Ansah Gyan has reported that his cage construction is nearly complete. Rev. Stanley Kelly Quaye's cage is not yet ready, and the Superintendent has advised that a replacement pastor may be considered if preparations are not completed in a timely manner.

Rev. Kube has been in active dialogue with Dr. Wisdom and Dr. Peku regarding sourcing rabbits at reduced cost. Dr. Wisdom is leveraging his connections with rabbit farming networks to identify farms where the programme can procure animals within budget.

A third interested pastor in Accra has been identified and his details are being prepared for consideration. Rev. Kube has also been proactive on financial stewardship — advising that the existing account balance is sufficient without requiring additional fund transfers at this time.

Quarter Activity Timeline

Early May 2026

Financial Stewardship Communication

Rev. Kube communicated to Dr. Allen that additional funds are not needed at this time. The existing account balance covers planned administrative and oversight expenditures, demonstrating responsible financial management.

4 May 2026

Rabbit Sourcing Consultation — Dr. Wisdom & Dr. Peku

Rev. Kube spoke with Dr. Wisdom (twice in one day), who confirmed he was working with Dr. Peku to identify rabbit farms offering reduced prices to meet the programme's budget. Dr. King Solomon also scheduled a vet visit for the Tanoboase farm.

7 May 2026

Field Visit — Tanoboase & Akrofrom (Bono East)

Rev. Kube personally accompanied Dr. King Solomon to visit Pastor Thomas Kodom's flock and Rev. William Inkoom Acquah's goats. Injections and deworming administered. Pastoral advice on feeding and shelter provided. Quarterly vet visits confirmed.

13 May 2026

Multi-Region Follow-Up Calls

Rev. Kube contacted Upper East pastors (Timothy Mambo and Dennis Atiah) by phone — animal health confirmed good. Rev. Daniel Obodum (Odumase) also confirmed goats doing well. Regional vet contacts followed up in all three zones.

Ongoing — May

Rabbit Cage Infrastructure Updates

Rev. Samuel Gyan reports near-completion of rabbit cage. Rev. Stanley Quaye's cage remains incomplete; Superintendent noted possibility of replacement. Third candidate identified in Accra by Rev. Kube.

Financial Stewardship

Consistent with the values of transparency and integrity that define the ELGF programme globally, Rev. Kube proactively communicated to programme director Dr. Allen that additional funds should not be transferred at this stage. The existing account balance is sufficient to cover planned administrative expenditures, oversight costs, and veterinary co-ordination for this quarter.

This posture of financial stewardship — reporting a surplus rather than requesting additional resources when not needed — reflects both the trustworthiness of Ghana’s programme leadership and the sustainability ethos at the heart of ELGF.

Priorities for the Coming Weeks

Rabbit Launch

Completion of cage infrastructure and sourcing of rabbits at cost-appropriate prices through Dr. Wisdom’s farm network, targeting distribution in the near term. A decision on Rev. Quaye’s participation or replacement will be made imminently.

Veterinary Formalisation — Odumase

Confirmation of the regional veterinary officer’s return and formal assignment to Rev. Obodum’s goat flock in Bono Region.

Rainy Season Preparation — Upper East

Dr. Ayine will begin preventive medication programmes for goats in Bolgatanga as seasonal conditions change, protecting the health of flocks during a period of heightened risk.
